1 Before the Court is the Motion of Josias N. Dewey, as Court-appointed Receiver
2 for the estate of Defendant Titanium Blockchain Infrastructure Services, Inc., for an Order
3 Appointing a Claims Administrator.

11 the Receiver (or Receiver’s counsel, as the case may be), RFS shall be deemed to
12 have been appointed by this Court as Claims Administrator for the claims process in
13 the above-captioned action.
